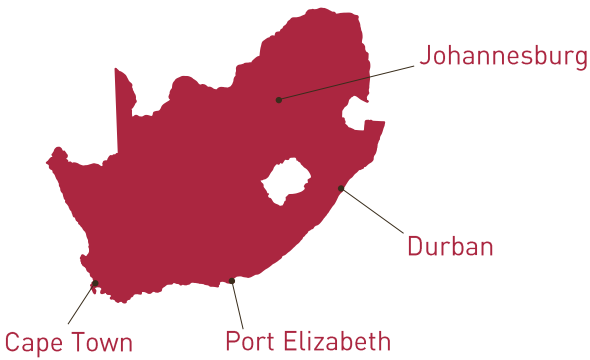

50% have sex 1-4 times per month

Risk of HIV/STI

31% are UNSURE of risk

75%* in long-term monogamous relationship
66%* know the HIV status of their sexual partner

Johannesburg – 92% urban

95% have had HIV test

Risk of pregnancy

54% do NOT feel at risk

Relationship status

65% single moms
19% believe partner is faithful

24% have sex 5-9 times per month

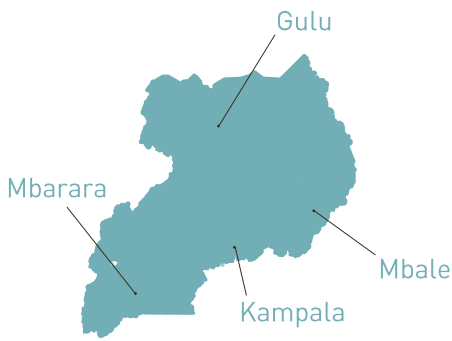
Risk of HIV/STI

General

Education

68% part / completed high school

Relationship status

97% of women who are married live with their partner

Partner's HIV status

36% know the HIV status of their current partner(s)

32% do NOT know the HIV status of their current partner(s)

Lagos – 95% urban

Religion

69% Christian
 30%* Muslim

Discuss pregnancy HIV/STI prevention

80% discuss pregnancy and HIV/STI prevention

Risk of pregnancy

28% feel at risk

Sex frequency

41% have sex 1-3 times per month

Condom use

60% most often used condoms | 46% do NOT use condoms all the time | 20% find it difficult to negotiate use

Employment

53%* employed | 38% student | 1% homemaker

HIV test

45%* have NOT had an HIV test

Risk of HIV/STI

33% do NOT feel at risk

Relationship status

45% have only had 1 sexual partner | 22% believe their partner is faithful

Abuja – 54% urban

Religion

88% Christian
 12%* Muslim

Risk of pregnancy

10% feel at risk

Sex frequency

46% have sex 6-9 times per month

Condom use

66% most often used condoms | 26% do NOT use condoms all the time | 46% do NOT find it difficult to negotiate use

Employment

26% employed | 28% student | 20% homemaker

HIV test

88% have had an HIV test

Risk of HIV/STI

48% do NOT feel at risk

Relationship status

70%* have only had 1 sexual partner | 48% believe their partner is faithful

Risk of pregnancy

44%* feel at risk

Sex frequency

40%* have sex 6-9 times per month

Condom use

82%* most often used condoms | 28% do NOT use condoms all the time | 50% do NOT find it difficult to negotiate use

Employment

13% employed | 48% student | 15% homemaker

HIV test

79% have had an HIV test

Risk of HIV/STI

36%* do NOT feel at risk

Relationship status

41% have only had 1 sexual partner | 38% believe their partner is faithful

Enugu – 81% urban

Religion

99%* Christian
 -% Muslim

Discuss pregnancy HIV/STI prevention

84% discuss pregnancy and HIV/STI prevention

Risk of pregnancy

27% feel at risk

Sex frequency

30% have sex 10 or more times per month

Condom use

58% most often used condoms | 44% do NOT use condoms all the time [23%* use withdrawal] | 30% find it difficult to negotiate use

Employment

36% employed | 46% student | 5% homemaker

HIV test

89%* have had an HIV test

Risk of HIV/STI

38% do NOT feel at risk

Relationship status

36% have only had 1 sexual partner | 36% believe their partner is faithful
